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Class Description:

This is a one year science course that consists of 16 modules. We will cover one module every 2 weeks. Some of the topics that will be covered are: Cell Biology, Genetics, and many of God's creatures from Kingdoms Plantae, Animalia, Fungi, Monera, and Protista. We will also perform several dissections, such as starfish, grasshopper, clam, earthworm, crayfish, fish, and frog. Your student will also become familiar with how to use a microscope.

This is a rigorous high school course. Students should expect to spend 30-60 minutes a day completing coursework. All experiments will be conducted in class. Students will take their tests at home and bring them back to the next class session completed. Weekly emails will be sent to communicate homework and test schedules.
