Course Description: In this fun class, students will learn about Michigan's history, landmarks, animals and more! Class time will include read-alouds with students then having hands-on activities and experiments based on the reading. Facts and ideas will come to life as they spend time together mapping, building, coloring and experimenting! Homework will be minimal, with two semester projects (building/painting/cooking/lapbook, etc.) that will be shown in class. My goal for this class is that students will not only learn Michigan's history, but also understand and appreciate all that our state has to offer!

Materials Needed: Maps and other required work will be provided by me. Students will need a pen or pencil, a box of at least 24 colored pencils and a fine-line felt marker (like a Sharpie).
