- Possibly assisting with pizza days, and other KAT events like the Kalamazoo EXPO (Saturday in March) if you are able. (Not all PAC member are necessary for these days)
- Communicating promptly by email; you must have the ability and inclination to answer emails.
- Be willing to enforce and support guidelines and policies
