

WRITING WORKSHOP

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About the Instructor:

Nancy has been teaching at KAT since 2008. She has a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from Plymouth State College in New Hampshire and a master's degree in Literacy Education from the University of Southern Maine. For over 15 years she taught in elementary classrooms throughout New England before starting her family and moving to Michigan. Over the years she has taught writing to hundreds of students. Both of her sons are homeschool graduates.

About the Course:

This is the first level of Writing Workshop. It is a year-long class designed primarily for middle schoolers (and very early high schoolers with no formal writing experience) to help them become strong, confident, and effective writers. During the year we will meet weekly to practice different types of writing. Basic grammar, spelling, and punctuation will be addressed within the context of the writing assignments. Homework will be assigned each week. **Parents are expected to take an active role helping students complete the assignments.**

Materials:

There will be no textbook for this course. Handouts will be provided. Students will need access to a computer, printer, and email.
