

Introduction to Photography (Grades 10-12)

Course Overview:

This comprehensive, year-long photography course is designed for aspiring photographers of all skill levels who are ready to grow their technical abilities and creative vision. Over 34 weeks, students will explore every major aspect of photography—from the fundamentals of camera operation and exposure, to advanced composition, lighting, editing, and storytelling. Each session builds sequentially to provide a structured and immersive learning experience, culminating in a final portfolio-worthy photography project and exhibition.

Grading; Subjective but Technical

As art is a highly subjective thing their grading will fit the corresponding subjects we are covering over that week and be more based on the technical and knowledge aspects for the art.

Students will have a summer project and a overall pretest before the first semester, a midterm at the end of the first semester, and a final exam followed along with their Portfolio and final presentation.

Tuition and Time; 34 weekly Classes (5th period, 1.5 hours) **\$400 Total** (\$200 Per Semester)

At Registration a placeholder fee of \$100 is required (Non refundable). *This goes towards the first semesters \$200 overall tuition.*

Day 1 of first semester the remaining \$100 is due by the end of the first class (Or the full \$200 for the course if you signed up after the Initial Registration days by the beginning of the 2nd weeks class)

Day 1 of second semester the \$200 is due by the end of the first class

Tuition is refundable in any case up to the original placeholder of \$100 by the end off the 2nd class of the corresponding semester up until Friday that week at midnight.

Camera Equipment is recommended however not required. Rental Equipment will be available for students at a 1 time fee of \$25 which covers the full year course rental agreement for any available equipment via a signout sheet with the rental equipment handling agreement.

Homework will be amongst the corresponding packet given to parents and any video material required will be linked in the corresponding email, *After Approval By KAT Boardmembers*

By the end of the course, students will have transformed from casual shooters to confident image-makers, equipped with the skills, tools, and mindset needed to create compelling photographs with intention and impact.
