

The World's Story

Grades 6-8

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Course Description: This year the students will study the age of explorers through the modern age. They will learn about the wars, revolutions, and culture changes that defined these times. This curriculum has a student book and a teacher's guide with student worksheets that include comprehension questions, mapwork, timelines, digging deeper activities, and other hands-on projects.

This class is taught on a three- year loop.

Year 1- The Ancients

Year 2- The Middle Ages

Year 3- The Modern Age

Course Materials Needed: The World's Story 3 Set, [student and teacher guide], a 3- ring binder for homework papers.

Homework and Class Expectations: Students will be assigned weekly reading plus a variety of worksheets and activities to do. Some of the activities we work on throughout the year are digging deeper activities, memorizing bible verses, review sheets, and quizzes about every 5 weeks. Students need to keep their homework in their 3-ring binder and bring it to class each week.
