

America's Story
Grades 3-6

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Course Description: This year students will be learning about the Civil War, the Transcontinental Railroad, American Immigration, and many other exciting events. This curriculum has a student book and a teacher's guide with student worksheets that include map work, comprehension questions, a timeline, hands on projects, and artist studies.

This class is taught on a three- year loop

Year 1- Ancient Americas to the Gold Rush

Year 2- Civil War to the Industrial Revolution

Year 3- Early 1900's to Modern Times

Course Material Needed: America's Story 2 set, and a 3- ring binder for homework papers.

Homework and Class Expectations: Students will be assigned weekly reading plus a variety of worksheets and activities. Some of the activities we work on throughout the year are state reports, map work, and memorizing the presidents. We also have a Quiz Bowl about every 5 weeks. Students need to keep their homework in their 3-ring binder and bring it to class each week.
