For whom: The tutoring is geared for 5 year old children through adults who:

- are diagnosed with dyslexia OR
- have a suspected diagnosis of dyslexia OR
- struggle with reading, writing, and/or spelling

About the tutor: Kristen Greene is a homeschool mom of four and has homeschooled for eleven years. Before homeschooling, she was a 7th grade ELA teacher for six years at a public school. Her love for teaching has led her to seek out effective ways to teach reading, writing, and spelling. Using a multi-sensory approach and an Orton-Gillingham based method, Kristen personalizes every tutoring session and looks forward to helping your child reach his or her goals.

Materials: All of the material will be provided by Kristen.

Cost: \$30/session (It is HIGHLY encouraged to schedule two sessions a week and continue throughout the summer.) One session will be held at KAT on Monday, and the

second session will be determined between tutor and parent. Each session is 50-55 minutes.

Frequently asked questions:

How long should my child be tutored?

Each session is personalized and scheduled at the pace of each individual child. The lessons are sequential and are part of a systematic program. On average, most individuals complete the program in 18 months to three years. In order for your child to have the greatest success, it is highly recommended to have consistent tutoring sessions (during the school year and summer) and to complete the full program. Some families opt for extra sessions during the summer since most drop core subjects during this time.

Will I be charged if my child is ill, or if our family is going out of town for vacation?

No, you will not be charged. Please give as much advance notice as possible, though, if your family is going out of town on vacation. If your child is ill, please contact me at your earliest convenience. I am a mother of four and expect that there will also be sessions in which I will have to cancel due to my family's vacation or family member's illness. We will extend grace towards each other and pray for healthy families!

When and how do I pay tuition?

Please pay on a weekly basis. So, for most weeks, \$60 will be due on Friday. I prefer PayPal or check.

Will the tutoring rate stay the same for the duration of the program?

I am in the process of earning three levels of certifications from the Barton Reading, Writing, and Spelling System; and as my certifications are added, the session rate will increase. The rate of \$30/session will remain for 2023, but I anticipate an increase in the tutoring rate in either January or June of 2024.

Do I have to wait until the start of the school year or semester to begin tutoring for my child?

Tutoring can begin anytime! It is not limited to the start of a semester or new school year.
