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About Me: As a freelance teacher in West Michigan I teach a variety of subjects including: music/percussion, apologetics, Biblical Greek as well as driver's training. About the class: In your first year of Biblical Greek we will focus on the basics of the language. This will mostly entail learning the alphabet, vocabulary and the grammar of the language. Translation will also be an ongoing aspect of our study. As the textbook states, "By the end of year one you will have learned over 100 vocabulary words, 10 memory verses and several important grammatical concepts".

Why Koine Greek? Studying Koine Greek has many benefits. First, personal enrichment. A study of Koine will deeply enrich one's study of the Bible given that Greek is the language God chose to communicate the Gospel. Furthermore, all modern translations are based on this language. Second, ministerial study. By learning Greek anyone seeking to communicate God's word will be better prepared to do so more fully and accurately. Finally, academic progress. Not only will you learn about Greek grammar, etc. but also ancient history and culture. In addition you will gain insights into English grammar and mechanics.
